April 17, 2015

This week, the Senate passed that chamber's version of the two-year, \$211 billion budget that spends more than the House version and covers previously proposed property and franchise taxes cuts. A conference committee will reconcile the differences.

Debate between the two chambers on how taxes will be cut continues. The Senate's plan cuts nearly \$4.5 billion in taxes by reducing the franchise tax by 15 percent and exempt businesses making less than \$4 million annually. The Senate budget spends more than \$2 billion to cover the costs of a local property tax cut. The House's tax cut plan cuts sales taxes instead of property taxes, by reducing the statewide sales tax from 6.25 percent to 5.95 percent. The House also cuts more than \$2 billion to the franchise tax, including a 25 percent across-the-board rate reduction.

After six hours of debate, the House passed a bill allowing licensed open carry of handguns.

The BLS is tracking legislation in ten (10) general subject-matter categories. Periodic updates will come in two parts, the first part, below, is a summary of the categories. The second part contains a detailed list of all bills being tracked within the categories.

A -- Section Prepared Bills

Bills in this category are proposed by the Texas Business Law Foundation ("TBLF").

Business Organization Code—Corporations

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting corporations and fundamental business transactions developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2142</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 860</u> (Eltife) — House bill was set on House Calendar for Wednesday, April 15, and then postponed until April 29. The postponement will permit the Senate bill to be heard by B&I and ultimately substituted for the House bill on the House floor. The Senate bill passed the Senate and has been received in the House but not yet referred to committee.

Business Organization Code — Partnerships and LLCs

Substantive and technical amendments to the BOC affecting partnerships and limited liabilities companies developed by the BLS BOC Drafting Committee.

<u>HB 2144</u> (Oliviera)/<u>SB 859</u> (Eltife) — House B&I voted out the committee substitute addressing minor corrections. The Senate bill passed the Senate and is referred to B&I in the House.

Uniform Commercial Code — Chapter 1

Modifies the definition of a "person" to include a series LLC.

 $\underline{\text{HB 3434}}$ (Parker)/ $\underline{\text{SB 1077}}$ (Eltife) — House bill was heard in B&I on April 14 with Karen Neeley testifying. The Senate bill passed the Senate and is awaiting committee referral in the House.

B -- Business Courts

Chancery Court

<u>HB 1603</u> (Villalba) – Creates a chancery court system in Texas to handle specific business litigation. B&I voted out the bill on a 4-3 vote last Thursday. The committee adopted three amendments: 1) establishing an amount in controversy for a qualified transaction at \$10 million; 2) increasing the general amount in controversy from \$1 million to \$10 million; and 3) requiring severance for DTPA, Estates Code, Family Code, and trust actions. Opposition continues from TTLA, ABOTA, and the Texas Association of Defense Counsel. The process now moves to the Calendars Committee.

C -- Business Entities

Trusts

<u>HB 3762</u> (Elkins)—Amends Section 101.003 of the Property Code to permit a settlor of an express trust to designate the trust as a "business purpose trust" in the trust instrument, so that the trust can be considered a legal organization and treated as a business trust. Referred to B&I.

<u>HB 2534</u> (Parker)/<u>SB 875</u> (Eltife)—Enforces State Banking Commissioner regulation over "state trust companies." House bill was referred to Investments Committee. Senate Bill passed the Senate and is awaiting committee referral in the House.

LLC Charging Orders

SB 433 (Burton) – Amends the BOC to make Section 101.112, relating to member's membership interest subject to a charging order, applicable to both single-member limited liability companies and multiple-member limited liability companies. Referred to Senate B&C.

LP & PA Filing Requirements

HB 2891 (Otto)/SB 1541 (Perry)—Adds limited partnerships and professional associations to Comptroller public information report filing requirements currently applicable to corporations and LLCs. Provides a corresponding exemption from SOS report or statement filing requirements. House bill passed Ways and Means. Senate bill referred to B&C.

Service of Process

<u>HB 241</u> (Leach)—Provides a method of substituted service of citation through a "social media presence." Texas Process Services Association testified in favor while the Justice of the Peace and Constables Association testified against. Pending in House Judiciary.

Business Names

HB 2753 (Villalba)—Amends Section 5.053 of the BOC to adopt a "distinguishable" business name standard rather than the current "deceptively similar" standard. Conforms to the trend in most states and the MCBA. Supported by the SOS. A committee substitute makes drafting changes and amends Section 5.102, relating to prohibitions and exceptions of reservations of certain names, and Section 5.153, relating to prohibitions and exceptions of certain registrations. Lori Ann Fox testified. Voted out of B&I.

SB 1973 (V. Taylor)—Intended to be Senate companion of HB 2753, but not considered an official companion due to drafting error. Referred to B&C.

<u>SB 1313</u> (Watson)—Amends section 5.053 of the BOC to permit the use of a notarized consent to avoid application of the current business name standard. Placed on Senate Intent Calendar.

Non-profit Corporations

HB 3479 (Oliveira) SB 1233 (L. Taylor)—Adds new provisions to Chapter 22 of the BOC authorizing distributions of income to non-profit corporation members. House bill pending in B&I. Senate bill pending in B&C.

D -- UCC

Awaiting the filing of additional bills and identification as to relevancy.

E -- Securities

Crowdfunding

<u>HB 1629</u> (Johnson)—Directs the State Securities Board to promulgate rules regulating and facilitating crowdfunding in connection with non-profit and government loans for small business and community development purposes. Pending in Investments and Financial Services.

<u>HB 2580</u> (Johnson)—Requires the State Securities Board to promulgate rules regulating and facilitating online intrastate crowdfunding. Provides numerous restrictions and qualifications. Referred to Investments and Financial Services.

<u>HB 3425</u> (Parker) — Establishes an intrastate exchange in which crowdfunding and other federal exempted offerings can be traded. Pending in Investments and Financial Services. John Fahy met Friday with Chairman Parker's staff to discuss concerns with the bill.

Insider Trading by Public Officials

<u>HB 1539</u> (Meyer)—Increases criminal penalties based on threshold pecuniary gain amounts for public officials convicted of insider trading. Passed General Investigating and Ethics.

State Affairs. (V. Taylor)—Identical to HB 1539, but not an official companion. Referred to

Securities Licenses

<u>HB 2484</u> (Schaefer)—Amends Title 2 of the Occupations Code to require state agencies to waive education, training, experience and examination requirements for obtaining an occupational license if an applicant holds a substantially equivalent license in another state. Applies to securities licenses. Referred to Licensing.

<u>HB 3981</u> (Darby)—Would allow an occupational license holder the choice to have an administrative law judge at the State Office of Administrative Hearings render the final decision in a contested case instead of the head of the agency granting the occupational license. Referred to Licensing.

State Securities Board

<u>HB 2493</u> (Parker) — Provides for the SDSI status for the State Securities Board as state agency, and adds internal operating requirements and powers. Set on the House Calendar for April 21.

F -- Financial Institutions

Dodd-Frank

<u>HCR 26</u> (Flynn)—Requests Congress to repeal the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Passed the Select Committee in State and Federal Power and Responsibility.

Consumer Credit Transactions

<u>HB 3094</u> (Parker)/<u>SB 1282</u> (Eltife)—Finance Code amendments relating to the regulation of consumer credit transactions and the regulatory authority of the Office of Consumer Credit Commissioner. The OCCC is preparing language to address TBLF and other concerns. The House bill remains pending in Investments and Financial Services. Senate bill passed B&C.

G -- Business Liability

Human Trafficking

HB 968 (Hernandez)/SB 1848 (Garcia) – Applies to certain legal entities under the BOC and would make a shareholder or member of an entity jointly liable under Sec. 98.002 of the Civil Practices and Remedies Code for damages arising from trafficking of a person if the shareholder or member caused or had knowledge of the entity to be used for trafficking. The bill is modeled after Section 21.223 (b) of the Business and Commerce Code regarding existing lawsuit liability for shareholders in fraud cases. Hernandez

accepted TBLF language in a committee substitute to better mirror existing state law. House Judiciary voted out the bill as amended. Senate bill referred to State Affairs.

Shareholder Oppression

HB 3168 (Simmons)— Amends Chapter 21 of the BOC to provide remedies for shareholder oppression in closely held corporations, apparently overturning the Supreme Court's decision in *Ritchiev. Rupe.* Heard on April 14 in B&I with TBLF opposition. Mike Godfrey registered as the TBLF witness and met with Rep. Simmons' staff on TBLF concerns with the bill. Communications with Rep. Simmons, Rep. Rinaldi and other supporters continue, including a meeting set for Monday with Rep. Villalba, the TBLF lobby team, TLR, Byron Egan and proponents of the bill.

H -- Real Estate and Related Topics

Power of Attorney

<u>HB 3095</u> (Thompson) –The REPTL POA bill. Jackie Akins is analyzing the proposed committee substitute. Direction to the lobby team is needed on any remaining concerns. Hearing set for Tuesday, April 21 in Judiciary.

I -- Taxation and Related Topics

Reducing business taxes is a primary issue for the Republican leadership.

Franchise Tax

<u>HB 32</u> (D. Bonnen) — Provides for an across-the-board 25 percent reduction in franchise tax rates and revises the "easy file" process and form. Passed Ways & Means.

SB 7 (Nelson)—Would permanently reduce the franchise tax rate to 0.85 percent for most taxpayers and 0.425 percent for retailers and wholesalers and modifies the "easy file" process by increasing application from \$10 million in total revenue to \$20 million, and by lowering the calculation rate from .575% to .331%. Passed the Senate and is awaiting committee referral in the House.

SB 8 (Schwertner)—Would increase the franchise tax exemption to businesses earning \$4 million or less in total annual revenue. Passed the Senate and is awaiting committee referral in the House.

Occupation Tax

<u>HB 2089</u> (Darby)/<u>HB 7</u> (Darby) / <u>SB 765</u> (Eltife)—Repeals the \$200 annual licensing fee imposed on a variety of occupations, including attorneys. House Bill was voted out of Licensing and incorporated into HB 7 (a comprehensive fee reduction bill). HB 7 has now passed House Appropriations. The Senate Bill is pending in Senate Finance. TBLF registered in support of this legislation in all three committees.

Property Tax

SB 1/SJR 1 (Nelson)—Increases the homestead exemption for school district taxes from \$15,000 to 25 percent of Texas home median market value. Also ensures that real

property conveyances can never be taxed. Passed the Senate and is awaiting committee referral in the House.

Sales Tax

<u>HB 31</u> (D. Bonnen) — Lowers the statewide sales tax rate from 6.25 percent to 5.59 percent. Would drop Texas sales tax ranking from 12th highest to 26th. Provides an average benefit of \$127 to Texas consumers. Passed Ways & Means.

J -- Choice of Law

Application of Foreign and International Law

Efforts to restrict the impact in Texas courts of certain perceived repugnant foreign laws or doctrines continue. Several bills have been filed impacting foreign judgment enforcement, and contractual choice of law and venue provisions.

HB 562 (Leach)/SB 531 (Campbell)—Narrows the application to marriages, suits for dissolution of a marriage and suits relating to a parent-child relationship. Passed House Judiciary and Civil Jurisprudence Committee. Leach indicated he will offer the TBLF proposed carve-out as a floor amendment. The Senate bill has been referred to the Senate State Affairs Committee.
